OUTPATIENT PROGRAM

FEATURING A RESIDENTIAL COMPONENT

Our program is Joint Commission accredited and licensed by the State of Maryland. We offer a unique approach to treatment, by combining the structured environment of an inpatient facility with the independence of an outpatient program. Our model of care is three phases and many of the areas we address are listed below.

Phase 1: Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP)

Phase 2: Intensive Outpatient Treatment (IOP)

Phase 3: Intensive Outpatient (IOP) Relapse Prevention

- Sponsorship, home group, step work
- Finding and maintaining employment
- Managing finances and maintaining healthy relationships with family
- Spirituality, anger management, co-dependency
- Healthy problem solving techniques
- Working through legal difficulties
- Court representation and reporting

Our clinical team includes a Medical Director, M.D. Board Certified in General Psychiatry and Addiction Medicine, Nurse, Licensed Social Workers, Certified Counselors, Life Skills Coaches and Support Staff, and a list of talented educators each with their own unique approach to teaching.

APPROVED HOUSING PROVIDERS

Our homes are nicely appointed to ensure the comfort of each resident.

It makes the transition from home to treatment easier and fosters a sense of family and community. We believe that a newly recovering person should never have to worry about the environment they are living in.



Our program provides the recovering individual with a task-oriented day that includes work, groups, assignments and 12-step meetings. You're held accountable for your actions and are given encouragement to do the "next right thing."

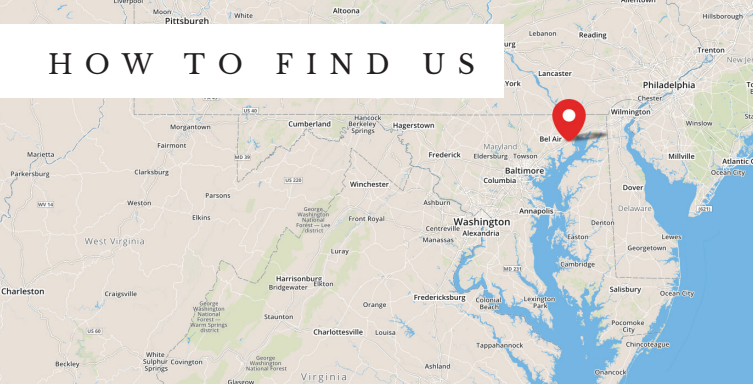

A D M I S S I O N S

Prior to admission we require an assessment that can be done over the telephone. Each person accepted into the program must be medically stable. Should you need detoxification we will refer you directly to one of our medical detox partners.

Upon arrival we provide a comprehensive assessment to make sure each person is appropriate for our level of care. We are in network with most Health Insurance companies and it is likely they will cover part or all of your clinical treatment. A cornerstone of the Maryland Recovery model is sober housing with approved housing providers combined with Outpatient services.

There is a separate fee for the approved housing component not covered by insurance. All financial arrangement must be made prior to admission. A financial sponsor is required and we do accept most major credit cards and cash payments.
